## NEWS AND NOTES

### THE SERIES

This is the first-ever game between Albany and Columbia. Albany began its 39th year of varsity football on September 3, 2011, while Columbia entered its 121st season of varsity football on September 17, 2011.

### CATCH AND RELEASE

Versus Fordham, seniors Mike Stephens and Kurt Williams each totaled more than 100 yards receiving marking the first time since 2003 that two Columbia receivers have done so in the same game. On October 11, 2003 vs. Lafayette, Travis Chmelka hauled in nine passes for 116 yards and Zach Van Zant caught seven balls for 123 yards and a touchdown.

### GRINDING TO A HALT

Last Saturday, Columbia held Fordham to just 77 yards rushing behind the stellar play of its defensive line. The line combined for 17 tackles, three sacks and five tackles for a loss. In particular, Seyi Adebayo posted three tackles for a loss and added a sack.

### WELCOME BACK

Players that missed most of last season due to injury had quite a season-opener. Senior wide receiver Mike Stephens recorded a career-high 105 yards receiving with a touchdown and 47 yards returning, while senior defensive lineman Owen Fraser had four solo tackles and a sack in the loss to Fordham.

### LAST TIME OUT FOR COLUMBIA

Fordham pulled ahead 14-7 in the third quarter and despite a late Columbia rally, the Rams edged the Lions 21-14 in the Bronx in Columbia's season opener.

### LAST TIME OUT FOR ALBANY

QB Warren Smith passed for two touchdowns and Pushuan Brown rushed for 125 yards and one score in leading Maine to a 31-15 victory over UAlbany on Sept. 17.

Seniors Mike Stephens, Ross Morand, Bob Hauschildt and junior Sean Brackett were elected as captains for the 2011 Columbia Football season.

## ZACH ATTACK

Sophomore linebacker Zach Olinger had a huge game in the season opener at Fordham on Sept. 17. Olinger registered a team-high 12 tackles, forced two fumbles and recovered one of those and added a pass breakup.

## LOTS OF HOME COOKING

For the second straight season, Columbia will play six home games on Robert K. Kraft Field at Lawrence A. Wien Stadium. The Lions have not played six home games in consecutive seasons since the 1980 and 1981 campaigns. Columbia is 5-2 in its last seven games at home.

## MARTIN STANDING TALL

Junior linebacker Josh Martin continued his fine play from a season ago in the season opener at Fordham. In the game, Martin had six tackles, one for a loss. He also registered a sack and blocked a 41-yard field goal attempt by Fordham's Patrick Murray midway through the second quarter.

## WINNER'S BRACKETT

Junior quarterback Sean Brackett returns under center for the Lions in 2011 after a sensational sophomore season in which Brackett was named first team All-Ivy League at the position. Brackett completed 57.8 percent of his passes a year ago, averaging 207.2 yards per game through the air. He threw for 19 touchdowns and was intercepted just six times. Brackett was first among Ivy League signal callers in pass efficiency at 136.1. On the ground, he was the Lions' leading rusher, scampering for 516 yards and three scores.

## ADAMS BACK ON THE BLIND SIDE

Anchoring the offensive line is three-year starter and two-time All-Ivy League left tackle Jeff Adams. Adams, a product of Western Springs, Ill., helped the Lions post prodigious offensive numbers in several games last season as Columbia averaged more than 22 points per game.

## FIVE UP FRONT

Columbia lost just one senior to graduation from its offensive line in 2011 graduate Ian Quirk. Four starters from last year return, including co-captain Bob Hauschildt, who moves to center after spending last season at offensive guard.

## IN THE BACKFIELD

Sophomore Marcorus Garrett, and junior Nick Gerst, Columbia's second leading rusher a year ago behind Sean Brackett, are expected to receive the bulk of the carries for the Lions in 2011. Both backs showed explosive flashes in 2010 as Gerst averaged 5.2 yards on 82 touches (rushing and receiving) while Garrett averaged 7.9 per carry in limited action.

## LET'S GO MURPHY

Junior linebacker Ryan Murphy is back after a strong sophomore season. The 6-2 linebacker registered four sacks a year ago and established himself as a versatile defender.

## MISTRETTA, OLINGER RETURN

Senior Nick Mistretta and sophomore Zach Olinger add even more strength to the linebacker corps. Mistretta has seen action since his first year while Olinger broke through in a big way late last year, coming up with 10 tackles, three for a loss and a sack.

## THE DEFENSIVE LINE

Along the defensive line, Columbia returns a number of veterans, including senior defensive end Ben Popeck, senior defensive tackles Chris Groth and Owen Fraser and junior defensive end Seyi Adebayo. Joining that group is sophomore defensive lineman Wells Childress, who transferred to Columbia last spring from Texas A&M.

## PRIMARY SECONDARY PLAYERS

Several veterans also return in the Columbia defensive backfield, anchored by co-captain Ross Morand, who is slated to start at one cornerback spot. Alongside Morand may be junior Brian DeVeau, who played wide receiver as a sophomore after beginning his collegiate career as a cornerback. At safety, senior Neil Schuster returns as a starter alongside classmate A.J. Maddox.

## WELCOME BACK

Columbia will welcome back three seniors who each had their seasons cut short last fall. Wide receivers Mike Stephens and Paul Havas are back to help the offense while defensive back Mike Murphy could also appear in the return game.

## I DON'T MEAN TO BE KURT

Senior wide receiver Kurt Williams had a breakout season a year ago, catching 27 passes for 400 yards and two touchdowns. It was the first full season for Williams at wide receiver after he was a defensive back for the first two seasons of his collegiate career.

## WE'LL TAKE IT

In 2010, Columbia was one of just three Ivy League teams to post a positive turnover margin. In 10 games, Columbia forced 20 turnovers and gave the ball away 18 times.

## NEW FACES, NEW PLACES

Three new assistant coaches will patrol the sidelines and coaches box for the Lions this fall. Defensive coordinator Chris Woods is in his first season at Columbia, where he will also coach the linebackers. Bill Lund is Columbia's new defensive line coach and Mike Neuberger will mentor the Lions' tight ends.

## LIONS ON TV

Columbia will play two nationally televised games this season, both at home. The Lions' October 15th game vs. Penn, which also serves as Columbia's annual Homecoming, will be shown on VERSUS beginning at 3:30 p.m. On October 29, Columbia's home game vs. Yale can also be seen on the YES Network, beginning at noon.

## ARCHIE ROBERTS, NFF DISTINGUISHED AMERICAN

In July, the National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame (NFF) announced that Dr. Archie Roberts, a prominent heart surgeon who played football at Columbia in the 1960s, has been named the 2011 recipient of the organization's Distinguished American Award. First bestowed in 1966, the NFF Distinguished American Award is presented on special occasions when a truly deserving candidate emerges. Roberts will become the 40th recipient of the award, joining an impressive list of previous honorees that includes Vince Lombardi, Bob Hope, Jimmy Stewart, Pete Rozelle, Joe Paterno, Pat Tillman, T. Boone Pickens and last year's honoree Tom Brokaw.

## Game 1 • Fordham 21, Columbia 14

In a game with eight sacks between the two teams, and outstanding defensive plays on both sides, it was Fordham's 100-yard interception for a touchdown that proved to be the key play of the game.

Columbia's defense put on a show of their own, holding Fordham scoreless after two trips inside Columbia's 30-yard line. Seyi Adebayo and Owen Fraser combined for a tackle for a loss and a big sack respectively on Fordham's second possession in the first quarter, which turned the ball over to Columbia on downs.

On the ensuing drive, Fordham's Andre Delaire picked off Columbia's Sean Brackett to the Columbia 20, but Fordham's first penalty pushed them back to the 30 for an illegal block in the back. This time it was Zach Olinger and Adebayo that combined to keep Fordham off the scoreboard. Adebayo sacked the Rams' freshman quarterback Peter Maetzold for a loss of nine yards on third and seven from the Columbia 14 yard line. Fordham attempted a 40-yard field goal that went wide right.

Columbia took advantage of a Fordham penalty to close the first quarter. Patrick Murray's punted from the Fordham 19 but the Rams were called for interference, which put the Lions on the Rams 33 yard line.

Brackett found Mike Stephens, one of two Columbia receivers to have over 100 yards receiving on the day, for a 19-yard gain and put the Lions on the Fordham 14. Two plays later, Brackett found Kurt Williams for the score. Williams also had more than 100 yards receiving on the day. Luke Eddy converted the PAT for the 7-0 lead.

After consecutive three and out series by both teams, Columbia's defense held the Rams scoreless after starting a drive on the Columbia 35. Neil Schuster, Mike Waller, Olinger, and A.J. Maddox combined for tackles on the drive. Josh Martin blocked the 41-yard field goal attempt to give Columbia the ball on its own 32.

The Lions pushed the ball down the field behind a combined 42-yards receiving by Stephens and some short gains on the ground by Brackett. On second and goal from the Fordham six, Brackett was sacked for a loss of seven but on the next play, Brackett used some tough moves and kept for 11 yards. On fourth and two, Nick Womack picked Brackett at the goal line and raced 100 yards to tie the game.

"We talked all week about limited unforced turnovers," Patricia and Shepard Alexander Head Coach of Football Norries Wilson said. "We didn't do that today, and we have a lot to work on before next week."

Fordham scored the go-ahead touchdown on its second possession of the third. Starting the drive on its own 35, Maetzold found Sam Ajala for a 60-yard touchdown score to go up 14-7 midway through the third quarter.

After Columbia drove down to the Fordham 18 and failed to convert a field goal, Fordham tacked on another score early in the fourth on five plays, which spanned 80 yards. Maetzold connected with Carlton Koonce for a 16-yard touchdown pass.

Columbia cut the lead to 21-14 late in the fourth when Brackett led the Lions 48 yards on nine plays, culminating in a 10-yard Brackett-to-Stephens touchdown pass.

Brackett finished 18-32-2 for 239 yards and two touchdowns. Stephens finished with a career-high 105 yards on eight catches and a touchdown. Williams totaled 104 yards on six catches and a score.

Maetzold was 22-30 for 212 yards and two touchdowns.

Columbia's defense, which played extremely well throughout the game, was led by Olinger who led all players with nine solo tackles and 12 total tackles, two forced fumbles and one fumble recovery. Marin had six tackles, one sack and one tackle for a loss, while Adebayo added four tackles, which included one sack and three tackles for a loss. Healthy for the first time in a year, Fraser had four tackles with a huge sack and a tackle for a loss.

## Patricia and Shepard Alexander Head Coach of Football **NORRIES WILSON**

Norries Wilson begins his sixth year as Columbia's Patricia and Shepard Alexander Head Coach of Football after the Lions posted four or more wins in consecutive seasons for the first time since 1997-98.

Wilson, one of the top assistant coaches in the nation while at the University of Connecticut, became Columbia's 18th head coach of football in December 2005.

Wilson's student-athletes have earned 28 All-Ivy League honors since 2006, including two Rookies of the Year and 11 first-team selections.

After a 4-6, 2-5 Ivy League season in 2010, Columbia had a total of eight student-athletes named All-Ivy League in football, the second most in school history. Among the eight, five (Sean Brackett, Alex Gross, Andrew Kennedy, Calvin Otis, and Jeff Adams) were named to the first team, the most since 1994.

Brackett became Columbia's first quarterback since Jamie Schwalbe (1994) to be named first team All-Ivy League.

In 2009, Wilson led Columbia to a fourth-place finish in the Ivy League, the Lions' best league finish in six years. Columbia also posted its most wins in six years. Eight Columbians were named to the All-Ivy League team, including defensive end Lou Miller, a unanimous first team selection, along with fellow first-teamers Austin Knowlin (wide receiver) and Jeff Adams (offensive lineman).

Wilson, who served as offensive coordinator at UConn for four seasons, was one of five finalists for the Frank Broyles Award as the nation's top assistant coach in 2004, a season in which the Huskies led the Big East in both total and scoring offense. In 2003, he guided UConn's offense that posted 477.5 yards per game, which ranked eighth in the nation.

In 2002, Wilson was promoted to the Huskies' offensive coordinator after joining the UConn staff in 1999 as offensive line coach. He continued to work specifi-

cally with the Huskies' centers and guards. In 2004, UConn defeated Toledo to win the Motor City Bowl. Three members of that team's offense went on to sign National Football League contracts.

Prior to the 2004 season, Wilson was one of 12 coaches selected to participate in the NCAA Expert Coaching Program. The program is designed to teach and reinforce various aspects of securing, managing and excelling in NCAA head coaching positions at the Division I-A level.

Before UConn, Wilson spent four seasons at Bucknell. He was the Bison's offensive line coach in 1995 and 1996 before a promotion to offensive coordinator in 1997 and 1998. He was also defensive coordinator at Livingstone College (1993), offensive line/tight ends coach at North Carolina Central (1991-92) and graduate assistant at his alma mater, the University of Minnesota (1989-90).

Wilson was a captain and two-year starter for the Gophers. In 1985, the team defeated Clemson to win the Independence Bowl and competed in the Liberty Bowl vs. Tennessee the following year. He was a three-year letterwinner in football, and earned two letters and qualified for the NCAA Championships as a heavyweight in wrestling. He graduated from Minnesota in 1989 with a degree in psychology.

In addition to his college coaching experience, Wilson has served minority coaching fellowships in the NFL with the Kansas City Chiefs (1992), the Jacksonville Jaguars (1995) and the Indianapolis Colts (2000).

A native of Markham Ill., where he attended Thornwood High School, Wilson is married to the former Brenda Marquis, who played forward on UConn's first women's basketball national championship team. The couple has three children: a son, Cecil, and two daughters, Trinity and Sahara.
