• Megan Griffith '07CC enters her first season as head coach of the Lions ... Griffith will be 31 years, 68 days old when she makes her head coaching debut on Nov. 11, making her the third-youngest active head coach in Div. I women's basketball ... Griffith played at Columbia from 2003-07 and was inducted into the Columbia University Athletics Hall of Fame on Thursday, Oct. 20 ... She is the program's single-season assists leader (148, 2005-06), fifth in career assists (373), and one of 10 Lions in program history to score more than 1,000 career points (1,061).

PRESEASON NOTES

BUILDING ON SUCCESS

• Columbia went 11-4 in non-conference games last season, marking its most non-conference wins in program history ... The previous record was nine wins, set by the 2009-10 team that posted a final record of 18-10, the winningest Div. I season in program history.

OLIVER CHASING HISTORY

• Senior Tori Oliver enters the season seventh in program history in scoring with 1,055 career points ... Oliver would need 393 points to surpass Ula Lysniak (1983-87, 1,447 points) as the school's all-time leading scorer ... Last season, Oliver scored 291 points (10.0 ppg) ... As a sophomore in 2014-15, Oliver scored 461 points, leading both Columbia and the Ivy League in scoring (16.5 ppg).

ALL-IVY RETURNER

• Junior Camille Zimmerman is a returning All-Ivy League selection ... Zimmerman was named to the All-Ivy League Second Team last season after averaging 14.4 points and 7.3 rebounds, both of which ranked top 10 in the conference ... Zimmerman has already amassed 800 career points in her first two seasons (14.0/game), putting her on pace to become the school's all-time leading scorer by the time she graduates in May of 2018.

GIULIANO FOR 3!

• Junior Alexa Giuliano enters the season No. 3 in program history in career 3-pointers made with 131 through her first two seasons ... Giuliano needs 36 to surpass Melissa Shafer for the record ... Shafer knocked down 166 triples from 2008-12 ... Giuliano drained 73 from long range in her rookie 2014-15 campaign to break Columbia's single-season record ... Last season, Giuliano tacked on 58 more, which is fourth in the single-season record books.

WORLD MACCABIAH GAMES

• Sophomore Emily Surloff will represent Team USA at the World Maccabiah Games in July of 2017 in Israel ... The Maccabiah Games are the world's third-largest international sporting event and attracts elite Jewish athletes from around the world. ... This summer, 9,000 athletes from 80 countries will participate, providing Jewish athletes the opportunity to come to Israel and compete at an elite level while also building connections with their teammates, competitors and the people of Israel.
